


**Travel directions** By car: Approach via Highway A 17 and take exit Nr. 8 (Bad Gottleuba, Geising, Altenberg) in

the direction of Geising/Altenberg. The route will be flagged from that exit.



### **Training**

There is a training map "Altenberg" (1:10.000) with controls for 2,00 € from Friday 3 p.m. on available (Europark Altenberg, Competition office).

### Parking/Transport

During the competitions there's a parking area between Altenberg and Zinnwald (GPS coordinates: 50.7479°N, 13.7547°O). Distance from Europark to this parking area is approx. 1.5 km in the direction of Zinnwald, from parking area approx. 1.4 km walk to the Biathlon arena (parking prohibited in Zinnwald). Please follow the parking signs beginning at Europark Altenberg. Parking fee is 2 Euro for both days. Please fix the parking ticket visible in your car. Parking at Europark Altenberg is for free, please follow instructions of local staff. No public transport is organized.

**Club Tents** 

Club tents can be installed in marked areas in the competition arena.

Catering

Catering with barbecue, snacks and drinks is offered during the races in the competition arena as well as during the prize giving ceremony Saturday evening at the Europark Altenberg.

### Accommodation

### Mass quarter, Europark Altenberg

The mass quarter (hard floor) is situated directly at Europark Altenberg. Large seminar rooms and sport areas are reserved for accommodation. Please do not enter these rooms with your O-boots. Smoking and cooking are prohibited inside the Europark. Please follow the instructions of the local staff. Departure on Sunday is till 11 a.m.

Breakfast is served Sat 8 a.m. -9:30 a.m. and Sun 6:30 a.m. -9:30 a.m. in a seminar room (2nd floor, with vouchers only). There are only 50 seats in the breakfast room. Especially on Sunday we have many attendees, please try to come spread over the entire service period and stay as short as possible.

Showers are available in the fitness centre (basement floor), Fri till 10 p.m., Sat 3 p.m. – 6 p.m., Sun 12 p.m. – 4 p.m. Washrooms and Restrooms are on every floor.

All participants take part at their own risk. All participants are responsible for insurance. Promoter, host, the owner of the forest, land owner and authorities assume no liability for damages that go beyond existing insurances.

### Privacy

With submission of entry participants agree to press and internet coverage of their entry data, results and pictures and publication of these data in Start and Result lists.

### Special attention should be paid to paragraphs 21.3 and 21.4 of the IOF competition rules:

"During the competition the only navigational aids that competitors may use or carry are the map and control descriptions provided by the organiser, and a compass. Competitors may not use or carry telecommunication equipment between entering the pre-start area and reaching the finish in a race, unless the equipment is approved by the organiser. GPS data loggers with no display or audible feedback can be used. The organiser may require competitors to wear a tracking device."

Along the track to the start you'll pass the competition area and a bird protection zone. Access is strictly forbidden there. Please follow any cordons and signs. The competition arena itself is situated in a water protection zone. Entering of water ditches, washing or shampoo is strictly forbidden.

A major road at the boundary of the map is forbidden to use (marked in the map with ISOM symbol 711). Please respect urban terrains and private areas.

Any violations will be punished by disqualification.
